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# **Buffalo River Elk Festival 2023 Terms and Conditions**

Terms and Conditions have changed. PLEASE PLACE **INITIALS** ON EACH LINE.

One booth consists of a 10 ft. x 10 ft. marked area. Vendor cannot assign or sublet booth space. Apps for shared booths must include info for all parties. Vendor placement will be at the sole discretion of BREF staff. Priority of booth assignment will be given to returning vendors who complete their application early. If accepted, vendor assignment will be based on date received, product selection, etc. A late fee of \$25 must be included with applications received after June 9 to be considered for inclusion in this year's festival. Purchasing electricity after June 21 will be an additional \$30 per hookup. Vendor must check-in during the assigned time. Check-in hours are Thursday	Food vendors should expect inspection of food operations by the Arkansas Health Department and the City of JasperOnly pre-packaged food can be sold in the retail area. Any vendor desiring to make food on the premises must submit a Food Vendor applicationIf Vendor is approved to sell a pre-packaged food item, the vendor must provide a copy of Proof of Liability Insurance naming Buffalo River Elk Festival, Inc. as additional insured on the policyIt is the sole responsibility of each exhibitor/concessionaire to obtain the applicable and appropriate state and local licenses and permits required. The City of Jasper requires a food permit in addition to the State of Arkansas.
5:00 pm to 10:00 pm and Friday 7:00 am to 9:00 am. Vehicles are not allowed within the festival boundaries after 9:00 am Friday until 11:00 pm Saturday. Vendors having vehicles on festival grounds outside of the allowed time will not be considered for future festivals. The Official festival hours are Friday and Saturday from 10:00 am to 11:00 pm. All booths must remain open Friday and Saturday from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. Vendor must bring enough products to be able to remain open all weekend. Opening early and closing late on Friday and Saturday is encouraged. Vendors may not remove merchandise or strike tent prior to 8:00 pm. Any vendors leaving prior to 8:00 pm will not be considered for participation in future festivals. Vehicles will NOT be allowed on the festival grounds until at 11:00 pm Saturday. This time may be later, depending on the festival crowd. Vendors may carry out items between 8:00 pm and 11:00 pm, but motorized vehicles are prohibited. Any vendor bringing in a vehicle before the allowed time will not be considered for future festivals. Vendor must use designated parking area. Exhibitor/Concessionaire parking is provided in designated areas only. With the execution of specified set up/lead in and	Vendor is responsible for collecting, reporting and paying all sales tax. Forms and information will be provided with the check-in packet. Arkansas law requires ven dors to submit a sales tax report and payment of sales tax to Buffalo River Elk Festiv during each day of the festival. Vendors that have an existing Arkansas sales tax permit can pay sales tax directly to the state and city in accordance with their usual procedure. Vehicles and storage trailers are not allowed for use as booths or to be near booths. Buffalo River Elk Festival does not provide parking or electrical hookups for recreational vehicles. We may assist in locating RV facilities. This is an outside event. Refunds will NOT be given due to inclement weather. The festival will continue except in cases of dangerous weather. Vendor is required to be present for the entire festival. If a decision is made to suspend the festival, Vendor will be notified in a timely manner. Buffalo River Elk Festival is not responsible in any way for loss or damage to Vendor's property. Minimal security will be provided after hours, and Vendor is re-
provided in designated areas only. With the exception of specified set-up/load-in and break-down/load-out times, vehicles will not be permitted at event site. Vehicles must be removed immediately when asked to be by BREF staff. Vendor must not park in barricaded areas or areas marked "no parking". Vendor may not ask for permission from local businesses to park in front of or within the area of their place of business. Senior Center and Bank of the Ozarks parking lot is reserved for Senior Center, Area Agency on Aging and Bank of the Ozarks business. Buffalo River Elk Festival, Inc. retains the exclusive right to sell Buffalo River Elk Festival merchandise of any kind. Vendors will not be allowed to sell any items that include the words, "Buffalo River Elk Festival" or any derivatives. Buffalo River Elk Festival, Inc. reserves the right to prohibit products, works or displays considered objectionable, inappropriate or disruptive and may do so without refund to vendors. The following items CANNOT be sold or distributed: bottled water, sports drinks, ice, alcohol-related products, tobacco products, and any similar items. This list is not all-inclusive. Buffalo River Elk Festival, Inc. has absolute discretion to decide at any time before or during the festival whether an item or product can be sold at the festival. If Buffalo River Elk Festival, Inc. informs Vendor that an item cannot be sold, the item must be removed from the Buffalo River Elk Festival premises immediately. Failure to do so could result in the closure of Vendor's booth.	sponsible for securing its booth. Active solicitation outside of Vendor's booth is prohibited. BREF reserves right to limit prices of drinks sold by vendors. Vendor agrees to abide by price cap set by BREF which will be communicated with letter of acceptance. Booth space is limited, and every vendor and/or product may not be selected. Photos of the set-up and detailed description of products/items to be sold are required. Photos must clearly depict all types of items to be sold. All items vendor intends to sell are subject to approval by BREF staff. Any product not specified in the application may not be allowed at the Festival, unless permission is sought and given in writing. Unapproved items must be removed from the booth if asked by BREF staff. Failure to comply may result in vendor exclusion from future festivals. Exhibition vendors may submit images of themselves creating the products. All displays, tents and structures should be of sound construction and designed in good taste. Buffalo River Elk Festival, Inc. has sole discretion to decide if any part of Vendor's booth does not meet its standards. Tent stakes are not allowed. All booth locations are either public or private property and special permission has been given by the property owner for use during the BREF. Thank you for your interest in the Buffalo River Elk Festival. We strive to offer our attendees a variety of quality crafts and artist wares. Our goal is to keep standards high and promote a safe, successful and fun festival.

Please note there might be changes to the terms and conditions of the festival. Below are a few key items for renting booth space at the 2023 Buffalo River Elk Festival. Please read all terms and conditions before submitting the application. Terms and conditions are located on the last page of this application and on the Buffalo River Elk Festival website.

We are excited to offer, for the first time ever, electricity to every vendor spot. This will provide 5 amps of power per vendor space. 5 amps is enough to power a fan, a phone charger or two, and a laptop. If you intend to run an A/C unit or anything requiring more than 5 amps please add electricity to your booth fee.

All fees are non-refundable for successful applicants. 100 % refund for applicants not accepted.

Sale of certain beverages is reserved exclusively for BREF, Inc. Food vendors may purchase these drink products from BREF for resale in their booth.

Applications that are not signed and dated or that fail to include pictures and payment will be considered "pending".

Applications received without payment in full will be considered "pending".

Pending applications will not be assigned a booth.

A signed application, if accepted, is a contract to participate in the 2023 Buffalo River Elk Festival. If accepted, a packet with information on booth location, check-in time and other festival details will be provided to Vendor during check-in at the designated Vendor Office. **Please note the location of the check in may have changed from last year.** 

Booth assignments will be made by BREF staff. We do not guarantee you will be assigned the booth of your choice.

Vehicles within festival grounds continue to be a problem. Please familiarize yourself with these boundaries and respect the festival rules to avoid possible accidents.

Vehicles are not allowed within the festival boundaries after 9:00 am Friday until 11:00 pm Saturday without prior authorization from the vendor liaison. These rules are in place to protect you and attendees from injury.
